Dear Parents and Carers

Year 6 Bredon Hill Walk: Friday 17th May 2024

On Friday 17th May, at the end of SATs' week (13th May – 16th May), Year 6 pupils will go for a supervised walk up Bredon Hill. Pupils should come to school wearing clothes suitable for a country walk. It is essential that everyone should wear appropriate footwear with a cleated sole and casual clothing (jeans/leggings/long shorts/waterproof) suitable for a hill walk. With what seems like the almost constant rain we have been having recently, pupils should also bring a spare pair of shoes/trainers for their return to school and a bag for their muddy ones. Everyone should be prepared for the weather conditions of the day, whether wet or dry.

The walk will start from BHA at approximately 9:30am. Pupils will have their lunch, either a packed lunch or school meal, as normal on their return from the walk. They should bring a snack and a drink in a small backpack to have whilst on the walk as they will not be in school at break time.

Pupils also need to bring any medication, asthma inhalers and sun protection.

In line with school policy, the children may not carry mobile phones. They will be provided with school cameras to take photos.

There will be no charge for this activity but we will need parental consent. To do this, please just log-in to ParentPay and choose the 'Year 6 Bredon Hill Walk' option and confirm consent before **Wednesday 15th May 2024**. Through selecting this option, you will also need to provide acknowledgement that the school currently holds the correct emergency contact details and medical/allergy information for your child on My Child At School (MCAS).
